

Nixon Visit Won't Solve War, Mrs. Binh Says

PARIS, May 22 (UPI) — Mrs. Nguyen Thi Binh, head of the Vietcong delegation to the Paris peace talks, said today that President Nixon would not end the Vietnam war through any "maneuver" in Moscow.

The only way to get peace on honorable terms, she said in an interview, is for Mr. Nixon to resume the peace talks and accept the plan she submitted to him nearly 10 months ago.

Mrs. Binh said that the Vietcong's Provisional Revolutionary Government still preferred a negotiated settlement to a military contest.

"No maneuver, no attempt to isolate and cut us from our friends—the socialist and other peoples—will succeed," she said commenting on President Nixon's visit.

"The war will not be solved in Moscow or anywhere else. It can only be solved here in Paris," she said.
