Allies Won't Resume

Paris Talks SFChronicle The United States and South Vietnam said yesterday they see no useful purpose in resuming the Viet-nam peace talks today as demanded by North Vetnam and the Viet Cong. "Everything seems to in-

dicate that what you are seeking is still a military victory in the field and not a negotiated solution at the conference table." the allies said in a joint statement to the two Communist delegations.

The United States and South Vietnam who broke off the conference May 4 said they would resume as soon as the Communists clearly showed an intention "to negotiate seriously on matters of substance.".
