VC Asks Talks

PARIS — (UPI) — The Viet Cong today demanded the United States return to the Paris conference table Thursday and negotiate a political settlement of the war.

The Viet Cong's Provisional Revolutionary Government called on the United States and South Vietnamese delegations to end their boycott of the Vietnam peace conference.

The United States suspended the regular sessions May 4 saying it would not return until the North Vietnamese and Viet Cong delegations showed they were ready to negotiate seriously.

A U.S. delegation spokesman said it was in touch with the South Vietnamese delegation and would announce a decision later on the new Communist request.
