**Tho Poses Two Conditions  
For New Kissinger Talks**

PARIS, June 6 (AP) Le Duc Tho, a member of the North Vietnamese politburo, said tonight that he would agree to further secret talks with Henry A. Kissinger, President Nixon's national security adviser, on two conditions.

Speaking with newsmen at a reception marking the third anniversary of the proclamation of the Vietcong's Provisional Revolutionary government of

South Vietnam, Mr. Tho said Mr. Kissinger would have to come up with a new proposal to end the Vietnam war. He also demanded a resumption of the semipublic Vietnam peace talks.

The Vietcong and North Vietnamese proposed earlier today that the peace conference, indefinitely suspended by the United States and South Vietnam on May 4, begin again on Thursday. The allies have not responded to this demand, but there were indications that it would be rejected.
