# Viet Cong Again Asks Paris Talks

PARIS — (UPI) — The Viet Cong demanded again today that the United States resume the suspended Vietnam peace talks, broken off on May 4 by Washington on grounds the Vietnamese Communists refused to negotiate.

The Viet Cong said it sent another note to the American and South Vietnamese delegations declaring the regular conference sessions must be restarted.

"We reaffirm once again that if the American government is really anxious about seeking a peaceful resolution to the Vietnam problem, it must stop immediately its acts escalating the war, restart the work of the Paris conference on Vietnam as usual, the Thursday of every week, and to start serious negotiations at that conference," the Viet Cong said.

The United States suspended the 3½ year old conference May 4 with the agreement of the Saigon delegation of the Saigon delegation. U.S.
