**24 Prisoners
Of War Listed
By Pentagon**

WASHINGTON — (AP) — The Pentagon said today the government has received a list of 24 Air Force and Navy officers identified by the North Vietnamese government as having been captured since 1970.

Fifteen had been listed previously as prisoners and nine as missing in action, the Pentagon said.

The list was given to the U.S. embassy in Paris last night by Walter Sohler, an attorney acting on behalf of Sen. Edward M. Kennedy, (D-Mass.)

“We understand Sen. Kennedy had been informed the list was available, and that he asked Mr. Sohler to obtain it from the North Vietnamese delegation in Paris and bring it to the U.S. Embassy,” the Defense Department said.
