Porter and Thuy to Skip
Session of Talks Today

PARIS, Aug. 23 (AP)—The chief delegates of the United States and North Vietnam will skip tomorrow's session of the Vietnam peace talks.

The American representative, William J. Porter, will be away "on a brief holiday in Europe," the United States delegation spokesman said.

Xuan Thuy, Hanoi's chief delegate, is "tired and has been told by physicians to rest a bit," a North Vietnamese spokesman said. Mr. Thuy was reported to have gone for a visit to the region around Grenoble.

Both men will be replaced by their deputies at the session, the 156th.

The Vietcong's chief delegate, Mrs. Nguyen Thi Binh, will attend the meeting, a spokesman said. Pham Dang Lam, head of the South Vietnamese delegation, is also expected to participate.
