
Pollster Says Vote for Nixon Not Reaction

Pollster Daniel Yankelovich cautions businessmen against reading a reelection victory by President Nixon as a mandate for a return to "older points of view."

The reasons, even if it's a sweep, do not mean "back to the good old days," because it will happen because of the public's angry mood and Nixon's success in eliminating Vietnam as an issue, Yankelovich said yesterday.

He told the American Mining Congress convention that despite a deepening backlash against social change, movements such as consumerism and environment will continue to grow.

As for Vietnam, surveying in the 17 most populous states has shown, the New York City-based pollster said, that the vast majority believe the President is doing everything he can to end the war.
