Los Angeles Rules Aid Unit For P.O.W.'s a Noncharity

LOS ANGELES, Sept 27 (UPI)—VIVA, the group that distributes prisoner of war bracelets, is not a chartable organization, the city Social Service Commission ruled visterday.

The organization gives out bracelets bearing the names of American military men help prisoner by the North Vietnamese and uses the money gathered, it says, to call attention to their plight and bring pressure on Hanoi by public epinion.

Originally taking its frame from Victory in Vietnam, the group now says its initials stand for "voices in a vital America."

The commission upheld a ruling by the city Social Service Department that VIVA is not eligible to obtain a charity information card.
