French Envoy Injured In Hanoi Going Home

HANOI, North Vietnam, Oct. 16 (Agence France-Presse)—Pierre Susini, the French diplomatic mission chief who suffered serious injuries and burns in Wednesday's air attack on Hanoi was scheduled to leave here today for Paris by way of Vientiane.

He will be accompanied by his son Jacques and two French doctors who flew to Hanoi on Saturday.

Reports said that Mr. Susini's condition was generally satisfactory although it continued to cause concern.
