CEASE-FIRE OFFERED
BY THE PATHET LAO

TOKYO, Oct. 18 (AP)—A
Peking radio broadcast said today the pro-Communist Pathet
Lao had proposed a cease-fire
coupled with a promise to release prisoners of war.
The proposal, calling for a

cease-fire between the United
States and Pathet Lao armed
forces, was in a statement an
nounced Oct. 10, the broadcast
reported.

The statement, as others in
the past by the Pathet Lao
called for the United States to
stop "completely and permanently" its bombing of Laos
and end all military action, including that by its allies.
