Portrait of Kissinger In Saigon

SAIGON — (UPI) — A South Vietnamese opposition newspaper today published the head and torso portion of the Harvard Lampoon's centerfold composite photo of a nude Henry Kissinger.

The photo atop the left side of page one of Dai Dan Toc (Great People) was captioned, "Kissinger has no more secrets."

Earlier in the day, the Vietnam edition of the U.S. Army daily newspaper, Pacific Stars and Stripes, appeared with a giant centerfold blowup of the Lampoon composite.

Another Saigon newspaper publisher said, "I am very tempted to print Kissinger's picture in my paper today with the title 'Kissinger Comes to Saigon All Nude.' But I am afraid it would be confiscated. People here do not have this kind of humor."

The Stars and Stripes bureau in Saigon said it had received no reaction to its centerfold.
