
The President Optimistic on Peace Outlook

GARRETTSVILLE (Ohio)
— (AP) — President Nixon
said yesterday there has
been "very significant
progress" in Vietnam peace
negotiations and declared:

"It's going to come out all
right."

Nixon's comment came as
he paused at a pumpkin
stand while motorcading
through rural Ohio during a
strenuous day of campaign-
ing.

As he stood alongside the
road, Nixon was greeted by
a young man who said he
had served in the Marines in
Vietnam. The man asked the
President about the negotia-
tions, and Nixon said,
"There has been very signif-
icant progress."

Nixon thanked the man,
who was not identified, for
his Vietnam service and
said, "It's going to come out
all right . . . it's going to
come out in the right way."
