American prisoners of war in North Vietnam will each be allowed to receive an 11-pound package and a card from their families for Christmas, according to Cora Weiss, co-chairman of the Committee of Liaison With Families of Servicemen Detained in North Vietnam.

Mrs. Weiss said she received the information yesterday by telephone from North Vietnamese officials in Paris, who specified that the packages be sent only "in conformity with already set regulations by post via Moscow by next of kin."
