

U.S. Attack On Haiphong Charged

North Vietnam accused the U.S. today of resuming the air war north of the 20th parallel with a heavy raid around Haiphong.

"Waves of many" U.S. planes dropped more mines in the coastal waters off Haiphong harbor, bombed the port and made rocket attacks on a "number of areas on the outskirts of Haiphong City," said a statement from the North Vietnamese Foreign Ministry broadcast by Hanoi Radio.

"The U.S. warplane attacks killed and wounded and created heavy damage and destruction," said the Veitnamtse-language broadcast.

The U.S. Command said it would have no immediate comment.
