U.S. Bombing Blasted by U.N. Leader

United Nations

The General Assembly closed its 27th annual session last night with a warning from its Polish president that resumption of heavy bombing of North Vietnam jeopardizes the world's carefully cultivated relaxation.

Stanislaw Trepczynski, Poland's deputy foreign minister said:

"In Vietnam, a horrible war continues to be waged against a small nation fighting for its survival. . .

"Now that peace in Indochina is possible and feasible, a new escalation of this war, so inhuman in all its aspects, jeopardizes the future of detente and carries the grave risk of increased tensions in international life."
