### Saigon Talks

#### Saigon

General Alexander M. Haig Jr., Henry A. Kissinger's chief deputy, conferred yesterday with the leaders of South Vietnam and Cambodia, ostensibly to explain the state of the deadlocked Indochina peace talks.

Shortly after his arrival here Haig conferred for nearly three hours with South Vietnamese President Nguyen Van Thieu, and then flew to Phnom Penh to see Cambodian President Lon Nol. *N.Y. Times Service*
