

Sen. Saxbe Gives Up on Nixon Policy

Mechanicsburg, Ohio

Senator William B. Saxbe (Rep-Ohio) yesterday renounced his support of President Nixon's Vietnam policies and said because of the renewed bombing he will now support anti-war efforts in Congress.

Mr. Nixon "appears to have lost his senses," said Saxbe, who has supported the President's handling of the war for the past four years.

"I have followed President Nixon through all his convolutions and specious arguments, but he appears to have lost his senses on this," Saxbe said of the President's decision to renew the heavy bombing.

"I can't go along with him on this," he said, adding that the bombing decision demonstrated "arrogance and irresponsibility."
