Rival Demonstrations

Washington

An end-the-war demonstration outdrew a win-the-war group on capitol grounds yesterday.

About 400 demonstrators in a group calling itself Clergy and Laymen Concerned held a memorial service for Vietnam dead.

About 20 persons, carrying signs urging military victo-

ry and led by the Rev. Carl McIntire lined up about 100 feet from the peace group.

The minister, using a bullhorn, invited the larger group "to come and hear the other side of the story," but was drowned out by the amplified voice of folk singer Joan Baez, who recently returned from a trip to North Vietnam. *Associated Press*
