North Vietnam and the Viet Cong reported yesterday that foreign countries have promised more than \$15 million in money and supplies to aid victims of U. S. bombing in the North.

A Viet Cong broadcast said the Swedish International Development Agency offered \$14.6 million to build two hospitals and the Swedish Committee for Aid to the Democratic Republic of Vietnam is sending medicine for bombing victims.

Radio Hanoi said the government of Denmark is giving \$700.000 for war victims in the Hanoi-Haiphong area.

At the same time, the government of Finland announced it is sending \$410,000 to North Vietnam "to help cure the recent destruction caused by combings."
