ILA Forbids, 7 Unloading of Australia Ship

SAVANNAH, Ga., Jan. 6 (UPI)—The Savannah Chapter of the International Long-shoremen's Association (ILA) was ordered today not to un-load a freighter carrying Aus-tralian cargo. The freighter, Pacific Ocean, was to dock at Savannah late in the after-noon.

The ILA has begun a boycott of Australian cargo in retaliation against Australian unions which have refused to unload American cargo because of the United States bombing of North Vietnam.

Joe White, president of the local chapter, said he received orders from Thomas Gleason, longshoremen's president, not to unload the ship.

White said a Swedish ship and an Irish Vessel, both carrying cargo from Australia, were expected to dock at Savannah in a few days and will face a similar boycott.
