

Bombing Vital, Schmitz Claims

IDAHO FALLS, Idaho (AP) — "If this agreement with North Vietnam works, it will be because of the bombing, not because it was stopped," says John G. Schmitz, the American party's 1972 presidential candidate.

"The peace will be temporary until the Communists feel free to move again," Schmitz said in an interview Tuesday. "This is the history of the Communist aggressor, and the North Vietnamese are no different.

"It is naive to think that by aiding an enemy we can change him into a friend."
