

Thai Army Alerted for Cease-Fire

The Thai army and police stationed along the Mekong Valley have been placed in a state of alert because of the chances of an imminent cease-fire in Vietnam, General Krij Punnakan, director of the Thai information service, said here yesterday.

The alert was confirmed at a cabinet meeting Tuesday.

According to Thai authorities, the cease-fire would only cover Vietnam, "and the Indochinese revolutionary forces would immediately push toward the west in order to gain the maximum amount of territory in Laos and Cambodia."
