The Justice Department asked the Supreme Court yesterday to prohibit the proposed trip to Hanoi by the Revs. Philip and Daniel Berrigan, who are on parole after serving sentences for destruction of draft records.

The Department said in a supporting brief, that Secretary of State William P. Rogers had deemed that a visit to Hanoi by the Berrigan brothers would not be in the national interest.
