A Peking Prediction On Vietnam

Tokyo

Premier Chou En-lai of China was reported yesterday to have said that three governments will emerge in Vietnam after a cease-fire there and that the U.S. will recognize them all.

The three governments to which Chou was said to have referred are the North Vietnamese regime in Hanoi, the South Vietnamese regime in Saigon, and the Provisional Revolutionary Government led by the Communist Viet Cong in South Vietnam.

In a dispatch from Peking, the Japanese Kyodo news service reported that Chou's statements were made during a meeting with Takeo Kimura, a senior member of Japan's ruling Liberal Democratic party.
