

Prepare for POWs

DALLAS — The Dallas News says arrangements are being made for hospitals at eight Air Force bases to receive returning U.S. prisoners of war once a Vietnam peace agreement is signed.

The newspaper said that special teams of doctors, psychiatrists, psychologists and social workers have been trained and are standing by to help rehabilitate the men as soon as they are returned from Southeast Asia.

Information about the plans came from wives of men listed as prisoners of war or missing in action, the News said.

Officials at Sheppard Air Force Base in Wichita Falls, Tex., denied any such program has been set up.

The News said the hospitals due to receive the men are those at the following Air Force bases: Keesler at Biloxi, Miss.; Lackland at San Antonio; March near Los Angeles; Maxwell at Montgomery, Ala.; Shepard; Scott near St. Louis; Travis near San Francisco, and Wright-Patterson at Dayton, Ohio.
