Nixon Nominated for Nobel

Washington

Senator Henry Bellmon (Rep - Okla.) yesterday formally nominated President Nixon as a candidate for the Nobel Peace Prize.

Bellmon, a member of the

Interparliamentary Union and thus qualified to nominate a candidate, made the nomination in a letter to the Norwegian Nobel Committee in Oslo, Norway.

"In my judgment, President Nixon's 1972 record of

initiatives and accomplishments, in pursuit of an honorable, meaningful and lasting era of world peace, is unsurpassed by that of any other statesman in this century," Bellmon wrote.
