

## U.S. Admiral Lands In Hanoi for Talks On Clearing Mines

HANOI, North Vietnam, Feb. 5 (Agence France-Presse)—Rear Adm. Brian McCauley, the head of an American mission in charge of supervising mine-clearing operations at Haiphong and other North Vietnamese ports, arrived here today.

The C-130 military plane that brought the admiral and his team landed at Gia Lam Airport at 10:20 A.M. after flying in low over the center of Hanoi.

By mid-afternoon, the North Vietnamese had given no details of Admiral McCauley's visit, and it was not known whether he had left the capital for Haiphong, about 60 miles east of Hanoi.

### 50 Ships to Participate

CLARK AIR BASE, the Philippines, Feb. 5 (Reuters)—About 50 ships on the United States Seventh Fleet have arrived at nearby Subic Naval Base for mine-clearing operations in North Vietnam, military sources here confirmed tonight.

Subic Bay provides logistics support to the Seventh Fleet and is a major naval repair base.
