Support of Truce Told By Agnew

SAN CLEMENTE — (UPI) — Vice President Spiro Agnew told President Nixon yesterday that Southeast Asia's leaders support the Vietnam cease-fire and are ready to do their part to convert it into a lasting peace.

In reporting to the President on his 13-day four of eight Asian nations, Agnew said he found tremendous interest in the cease-fire and particularly in the attitudes of South Vietnamese President Nguyen Van Thier

Agnew landed in California Friday after meeting with the leaders of South Vietnam, Laos, Cambodia, Malaysia, Indonesia, Thailand, Singapore and the Philippines. He conferred with Nixon at the Western White House yesterday.
