

Kissinger In 'Cordial' Hanoi Talks

Henry Kissinger and North Vietnamese Prime Minister Pham Van Dong met for a total of six hours yesterday in Hanoi in two three-hour segments, White House press secretary Ronald L. Ziegler announced.

"The atmosphere in the meetings has been cordial," Ziegler said.

Also attending the meetings for the United States were Ambassador William Sullivan and Richard Kennedy, an aide to Kissinger.

The North Vietnamese delegation also included Le Duc Tho, Kissinger's opposite number in the Paris peace talks, foreign minister Nguyen Duy Trinh and vice-foreign minister Nguyen Co Thach.
