Nixon to Send Orchids to POW Wives, Mothers

President Nixon is sending orchid corsages to every wife or mother of a released American prisoner of war on his arrival in Hawaii. Pat Nixon disclosed yesterday.

Mrs. Nixon told reporters that she wished she could say she thought of the gesture, "but I can't ... Dick thought of it."

The corsages are being purchased by John Davies, former director of the White House tour office, who now lives in retirement in Honolulu.
