

**POW, Dad****Meet for  
Last Time**

James C. Bailey died yesterday, five days after he was reunited with his son, a former prisoner of war who was released early so he could make the visit.

Navy Lieutenant James W. Bailey was released from a North Vietnamese prisoner of war camp ahead of schedule after the U.S. advised North Vietnam that his father was seriously ill with a heart ailment.

Bailey was returned home after an Ohio serviceman gave up his seat to the Navy pilot because of his father's illness.

The reunion occurred on Tuesday at the Veterans Administration hospital at Tuscaloosa, Ala. It was their first meeting in five years.

Funeral services for the elder Bailey, 75, a World War I veteran, will be held today.
