"The United States has . . . deliberately used delaying tactics," said a statement by Ngyuen Thi Binh, "and has not given up its policy of Vietnamization of the war."

The meeting was the first time since the Geneva conference on Laos 11 years ago that the U.S., the Soviet Union and China have sat down at an international conference table together. Strikingly, they refrained from

any verbal attacks against each other.

The other participants are France, Britain, Canada, Hungary, Indonesia, North Vietnam, South Vietnam, the United States and the Soviet Union.
