U.S. Pullout Is Resumed

SAIGON — (UPI) — The United States today resumed its troop withdrawal program in Vietnam just hours before the release of 106 more American prisoners of war by the Hanoi government, U.S. military spokesmen reported.

The U.S. Command said that as of midnight yesterday there were 10,787 American servicemen in Vietnam. The breakdown was 6667 Army men, 900 sailors and Marines and 3220 airmen.
