

In a large, bare room of the North Vietnamese prison, Ly Nam De, in downtown Hanoi, some personal possessions of American prisoners remained on Saturday, the day after they had been freed. This was the first time the former French prison, known as the Hanoi Hilton, has been empty in eight years.
