President and Mrs. Nixon announced plans yesterday to entertain all freed American prisoners of war and their wives at a gala dinner and entertainment on the White House lawn May 24

Deputy press secretary Gerald L. Warren said the men released from Vietnam prisons will receive a foreign policy briefing during the afternoon while Mrs. Nixon holds a reception and tour of the executive mansion for their wives.

Mr. Nixon will participate in the briefing. Secretary of State William P. Rogers and presidential aide Henry A. Kissinger also are expected to be on hand.

Warren said Mrs. Nixon personally was planning the dinner to be held on the south lawn beneath the Truman balcony.
