## U.S. Says Canada Wasn't 'Misled'

The State Department denied yesterday that it gave "misleading" information to Canada that steam-rollered the Ottawa government into joining the International Commission of Control and Supervision in Vietnam.

Spokesman Charles W. Bray said: "Any suggestions that the U.S. government misled the Canadian government through that period

are totally without founda-

These comments were made to newsmen in response to a Washington Post report that the government of Prime Minister Pierre E. Trudeau last October "was misled" by U.S. officials into believing that the signing of the Vietnam cease-fire accord "hinged almost exclusively on Canadian acceptance of a peace-keeping role in Vietnam."
