**Billets and Cafeteria**  
**Looted as G.I.'s Leave**

SAIGON, South Vietnam, March 29 (Reuters)—As the final phases of the American troop withdrawal were enacted today, several hundred South Vietnamese civilians broke through a fence surrounding Camp Alpha, the last American billets at Tan Son Nhut base, and looted the barracks and a cafeteria.

The civilians, all dependents of South Vietnamese servicemen living on the base, rolled back a wire fence and emptied the base cafeteria.

The cafeteria was to be handed over to the International cease-fire control force—representatives of Canada, Hungary, Indonesia and Poland.

All food and tables and chairs for 1,000 were taken. Fans were ripped from the walls. Milk vending machines and refrigerators were hauled away.
