Bill Seeks to Aid P.O.W.'s On Retirement and Pension

WASHINGTON, March 29 (AP)
—Senator Richard S. Schweiker,
Republican of Pennsylvania, introduced a bill Thursday to help returned prisoners of war toward early retirements and pensions.

Former prisoners, military or civilian, would be credited with two days toward retirement for each day in captivity.

The bill would also give former prisoners and their dependents medical benefits "for as long as needed to meet their physical and psychological needs."
