'No Information' On Report of 200 More POWs

The State Department said yesterday it has "no credible information... which would tend to support" the Rev. Paul Lindstrom's report that at least 200 Americans are still held war prisoners.

The Manchester N.H., Union Leader reported that Lindstrom, who headed the Remember the Pueblo Committee, said he had learned that the prisoners remain in Laos, Cambodia and China.

Lindstrom, of Prospects Heights, III., was quoted as saying that his information came from military, CIA and South Vietnamese intelligence sources and from State Department employees
