Nixon Sends

Top General To Cambodia

SAN CLEMENTE —
President Nixon sent his former deputy security advisor to Southeast Asia today to make a first-hand assessment of the situation in Indochina and the deteriorating military picture in embattled Cambodia.

But the Western White House firmly rejected any suggestion that the sudden trip by Gen. Alexander Haig, now the Army vice chief of staff, forecast the possible reintroduction of American armed forces into the Indochina area which they have just recently vacated.
