Miss Fonda, meanwhile, told newsmen that the media had taken her remarks about prisoners of war "out of context."
"I never blanketly said

that all prisoners of war are

lying," she said.
"I said the primary lie comes from the U.S. Government and that is the one

we have to concern our-selves with."

Miss Fonda said she believed POWs were lying when they accused the North Vietnamese of a systematic policy of torture.
