Ex-POW Says He'll Look for 'Traitors'

Colonel Theodore Guy said yesterday he will go to Washington next week to begin a personal investigation of fellow prisoners of war he said collaborated with the North Vietnamese.

Guy said he and other officers who were in command of the prisoners will investigate "the 2 per cent who

turned their backs on their fellow Americans for their own welfare."

"In my mind, they are traitors. They should be charged with aiding and abetting the enemy," Guy said at a news conference.

Guy spent five years in a prison in Hanoi before he was released last month.
