Son Tay Day Festivities

Components of tomorrow's Son Tay POW-Raider noon-time parade through the financial district were announced today by, Lex Byers, Chamber of Commerce coordinator of military affairs.

The U.S Sixth Army Band from the Presidio will lead the procession from California and Drumm streets, to be followed by a limousine carrying movie actor John Wayne; hotelman Ben Swig; Air Force Maj. Gen. Leroy Manor and retired Army Col. Arthur Simons, commander and rescue team leader, respectively, of the Son Tay raid, and their wives.

Then will come two of the Raiders, Army Sgts. Tyrone Adderly and Leroy M. Wright, and their wives. Adderly, Wright, Manor and Simons received medals at the

White House for their roles in the raid.

Cars bearing the Son Tay Raiders will precede the Galileo High School Band, followed by cars carrying Navy Cmdr. Render Crayton and Air Force Col. Robinson Risner, prison camp commanders, and their wives. The Son Tay POWs and the Fort Ord Band will wind up the parade, which will travel on California to Montgomery to Post streets.

The 12:30 luncheon at the Hilton Hotel will feature John Wayne, with Edgar Bergen as master of ceremonies, aided by Charlie McCarthy. Tickets, available to the public, may be purchased for \$10 a person in the Hilton lobby, at the door or at the Chamber of Commerce offices.

Tomorrow night's dinner dance at the Fairmont Hotel

Terrace Room will feature Wayne, Clint Eastwood, Red Skelton and the Andrews Sisters. The honored guests will be treated to the midnight show in the Fairmont Venetian Room by Swig.

On Saturday, the POWs and Raiders will hold private talks from noon to 3 p.m. while their wives shop and tour The City and Sausalito, courtesy of Gray Lines. A two hour sunset cruise for the entire party will be hosted by the Red and White Fleet of Harbor Tours.

H. Ross Perot, the Texas billionaire and philanthropist, is paying air fare to bring the POWs, Raiders and their wives here from all over the globe, plus hotel accommodations. Estimated cost is around \$250,000. Headquarters for the weekend are at the Fairmont.
