Ex-P.O.W.'s to Be Briefed On the Latest World Affairs

MONTGOMERY, Ala. April 25 (UPI)—The Air Force announced yesterday that 235 former prisoners of war will begin attending classes at Maxwell Air Force Base April 30 to bring them up to date on world and cultural affairs.

The former P.O.W.s in groups of about 60 each, will learn what went on in the areas of international, domestic and military affairs since 1965, including classes on women's liberation, race relations, drug abuse and changes in the environment.

Two former astronauts William A. Anders and Brig. Gen. Thomas P. Stafford, will brief the first two classes on the Apollo program.

Other topics to be covered include President Nixon's visits to Moscow and Peking, the admission of Communist China to the United Nations and negotiations for peace in Vietnam.
