

## Son Tay Parade at Noon Today

A parade to honor prisoners and the men who tried to rescue them from Son Tay prison will get under way at noon today at Battery and California streets.

Led by the Sixth Army Band followed by actor John Wayne at the head of a motorcade, the parade will wind down California street, turn on to Montgomery street and proceed for three blocks, ending at Sutter street.

A luncheon to honor the 85 Green Berets who raided the camp on Nov. 20, 1970 and the 66 prisoners of war who had been moved earlier from the prison is scheduled to begin at 1 p.m. at the Hilton Hotel.

Ernest Borgnine will be master of ceremonies at the luncheon, part of a weekend celebration sponsored by Texas millionaire H. Ross Perot at a cost, his aides said, that may run to \$250,000.

Aides said Perot is picking up the tab for transporting about 250 couples here — ex-prisoners, raiders and their families — some from as far away as the Philippines and Europe.

Perot is scheduled to attend a dinner at 8 p.m. tonight at the Fairmont Hotel, headquarters for the reunion.
