U.S., Hanoi Envoys Meet Again in Paris

U.S. deputy assistant Secretary of State William L. Sullivan met for a second time with North Vietnamese officials yesterday in what Hanoi said was a review of the entire Vietnam peace accord.

After a 5½ hour meeting at suburban Le Vesinet, Nguyen Co Thach, North Vietnamese vice-minister for foreign affairs, told newsmen: "We are continuing. We have reviewed the entire peace accord and all its provisions."

Sullivan is preparing for what the U.S. anticipates will be a mid-May meeting between presidential adviser Henry Kissinger and Hanoi's special counselor Le Duc Tho.
