

Kissinger, Tho Relax-- Deputies Do Talking

Henry A. Kissinger and North Vietnam's Le Duc Tho took a day off yesterday in their secret talks aimed at tightening the Vietnam peace agreement.

But their deputies met to discuss details of the negotiations.

Deputy Assistant Secretary of State William Sulli-

van and the North Vietnamese deputy foreign minister, Nguyen Co Thach, met in suburban Gif sur Yvette. The meeting, in a villa owned by the French Communist party, was the first to take place without the two chief negotiators since the new round of talks opened Thursday.
