SAIGON — (UPI) — A North Vietnamese officer denied yesterday there were any American prisoners of war still held in North Vietnam.

The denial was issued in response to a claim by a North Vietnamese defector

who said Friday he believed some Americans were still being held for use as hostages.

The North Vietnamese officer said there were "absolutely not" any American POWs still held by North Vietnam. "They have been released 100 percent as re-

quired by the Paris agreement," he said.

Sihanouk Consults Tito on Indochina

BELGRADE (Yugoslavia) — (UPI) — Deposed Cambodian leader Prince Norodom Sihanouk arrived Satur-

day on a visit to Yugoslavia at the invitation of President Tito.

Yugoslav Vice-President Rato Dugonjic headed a party of government officials who were at Belgrade's Surcin Airport to welcome Sihanouk.
