39 EX-P.O.W.'s Divorced  
Or in the Divorce Process

WASHINGTON, June 11 (UPI)—Thirty-nine of the 420 married American prisoners of war returned from Vietnam either have gotten or are getting divorces, the Pentagon's chief medical officer reports.

It includes men whose wives divorced them while they were in captivity, and other couples who have sought divorces since the prisoners were released.

Dr. Wilbur also said that four returned prisoners were returning to hospitals for treatment of emotional problems resulting from their imprisonment. He said these were among about a dozen men believed to have returned from Vietnam with such problems.
